Liam Glynn

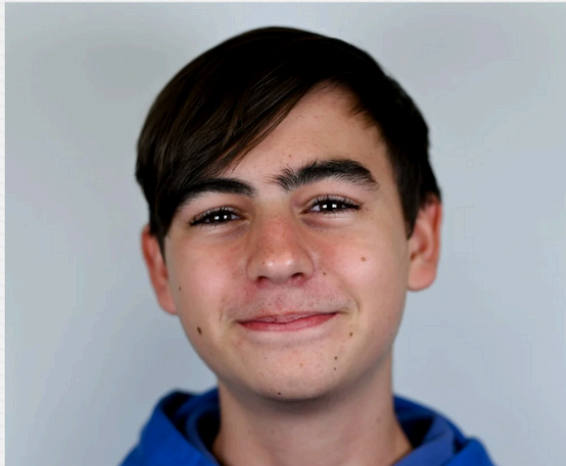
